

Sample Schedule: Elementary

8:00	Breakfast	Breakfast is offered to all students as part of the Academy Nutrition Program . It is a laid back time of sitting and eating together until dismissed to their classrooms at 8:30.
8:45	Beginnings	"Beginnings" is the first block of the day, when students start off with their homerooms in prayer, reflection and journaling about the weekly biblical value.
9:30	S.T.E.M. or Language Arts	Mondays and Thursdays are our "S.T.E.M." days, while Tuesdays and Fridays focus on Language Arts. Project-based learning allows students to apply theoretical knowledge to real-world situations.
	Break	10-minute breaks divide extended learning blocks, allowing for a mental restart and perhaps a quick jog around the field for some fresh air!
10:15	S.T.E.M. or Language Arts Cont'd	Rather than short daily class blocks, students are given an extended block twice a week to deep-dive into an academic discipline without interruption.
11:00	Recess	Daily recess times offer students physical movement, a mental break between classes, and the chance to apply their Social and Emotional lessons in a supervised atmosphere.
11:30	Bible or P.E.	Bible and Physical Education classes are core to our holistic educational approach. They focus on the physical, spiritual and ethical development of our students.
12:15	Lunch & Recess	Our Farm-to-School meal program incorporates seasonal vegetables from the Academy garden whenever possible! Lunch is enjoyed at our outside pavilion as weather permits.
1:15	Creative Arts	Students will all have at least one Creative Arts class each day, and courses range from Drama & Dance to Painting and Graphic Design. These courses are a delightful vehicle for academic, social and fine-motor skills.

2:00	Creative Arts Cont'd	Students know their classes by fun names like "What's Up, Stage?", "Pens, Pencils and Beyond!" and "Drop the Beat". Courses are tailored to the particular interest of the students, so that while learning the Elements of Design they may be doing so within a theme of The Animals of Africa, Robots, or Ocean Life.
2:45	Wrap-Up	During Wrap-Up students clean and organize their classroom and personal spaces, and review key content from classes.
3:15	Dismissal	For many Academy students, dismissal is a transition to Phoenix Sports practices and games!
